AccessArt has launched many successful Participatory Projects designed to give individuals and communities a sense of shared purpose and creative connection.

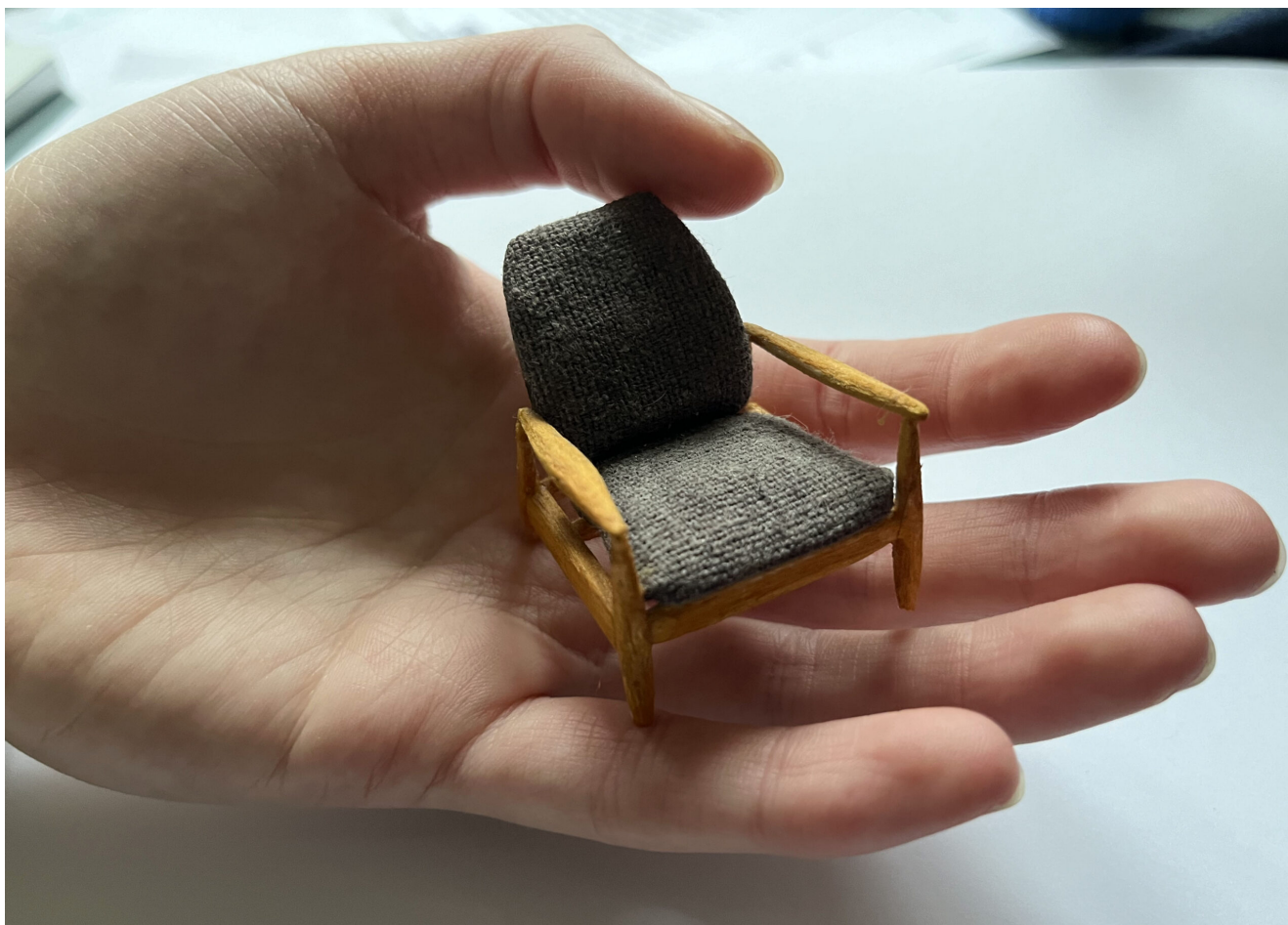
