

# **Book Artists for Ages 11 to 16**

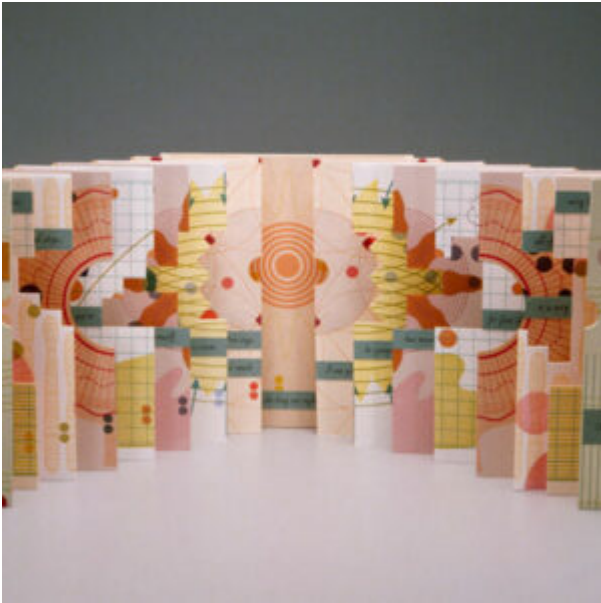

**Pathway: How Can I Create Sculpture Inspired by Books and storytelling?**



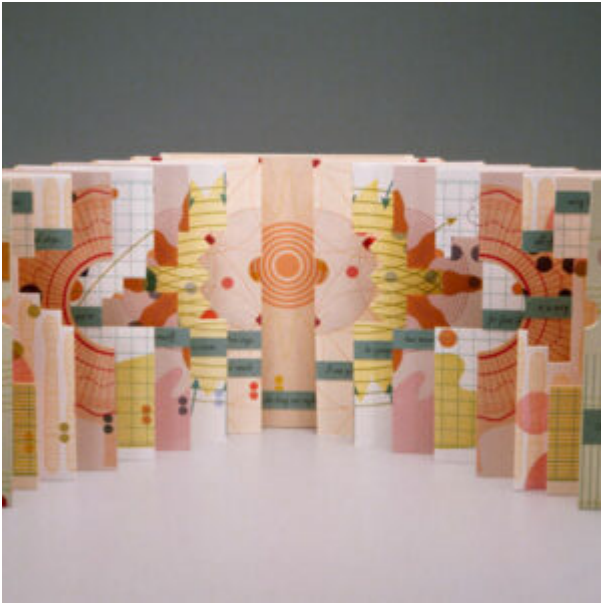

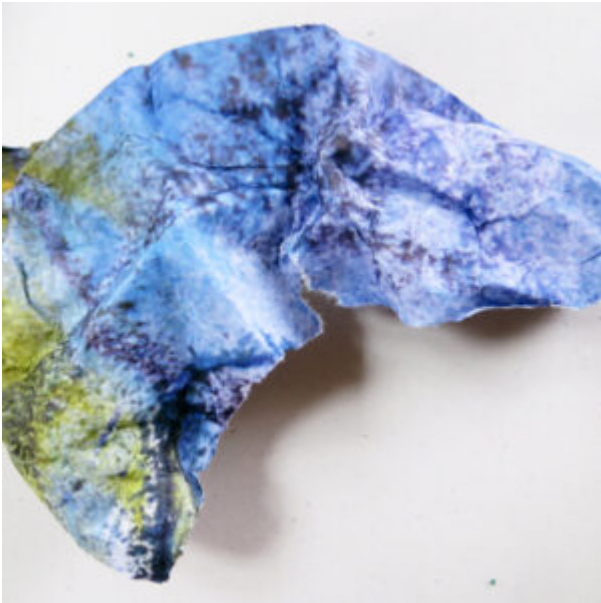
