# Creating and Drawing an Art Installation

In this session children helped create an art installation using art materials suspended from wires, in hommage to our regular art classes for children aged 7, 8 and 9. Children then made studies of the installation - using continuous line drawings and then graphite and soft pastels, resulting in beautiful and dynamic sketches.




