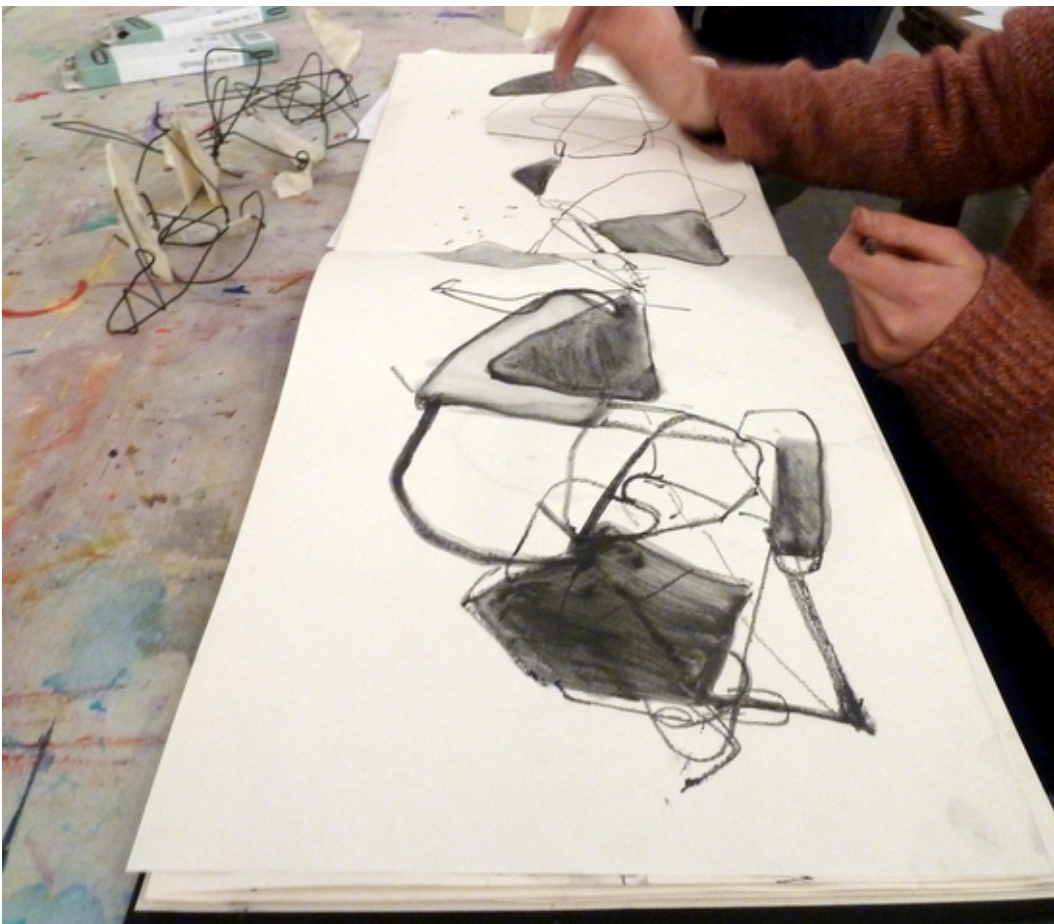


Drawing and Making: Drawing to Feed Making – Making to Feed Drawing
