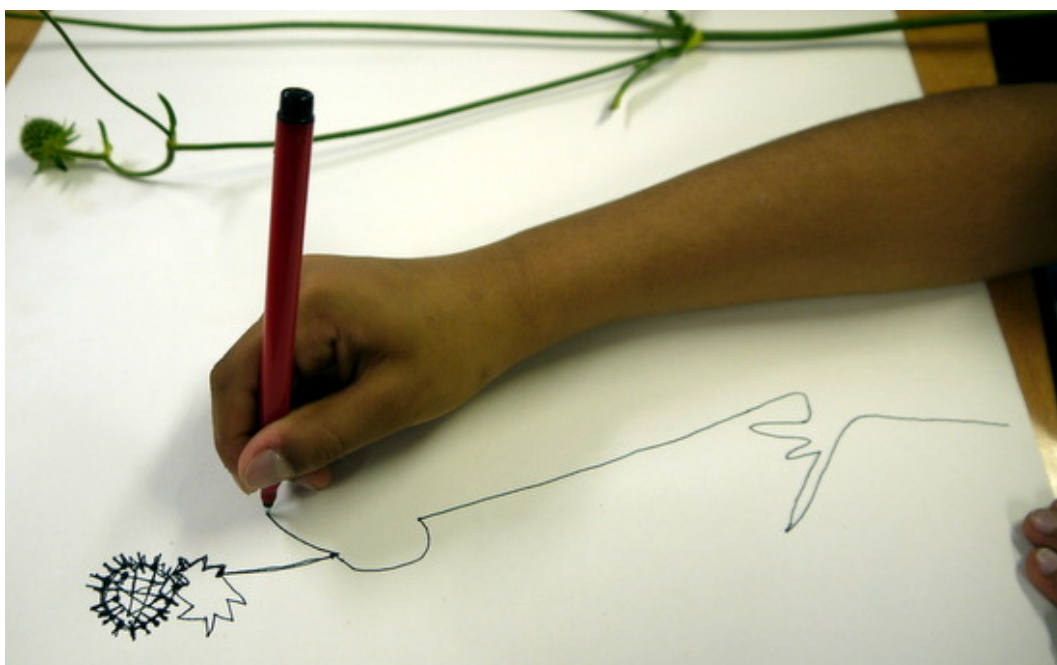


# Drawing and Making Flowers
