Nine months of organised trips, workshops, artist visits and last minute adaptations culminates in a final exhibition to celebrate the pupils work, inspired by their local community.

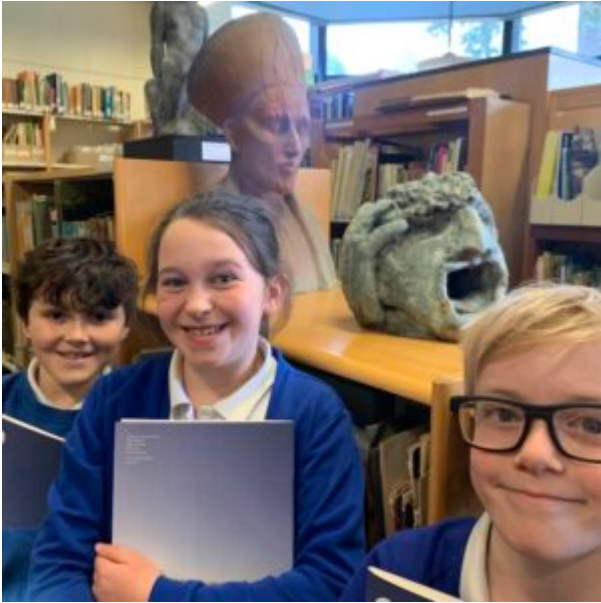
