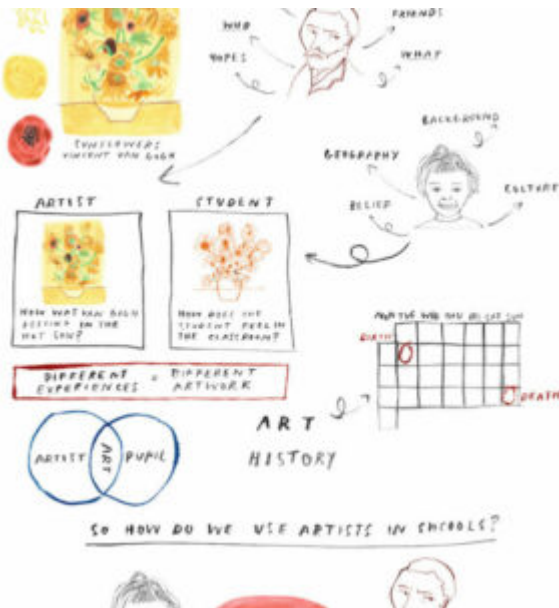

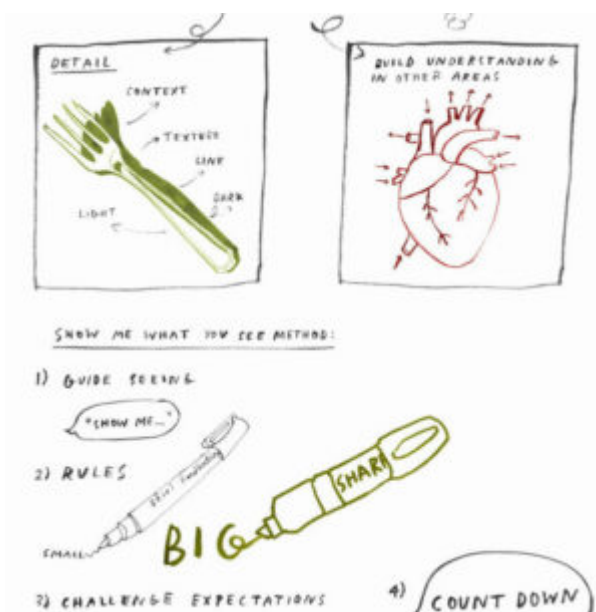
# Drawing
