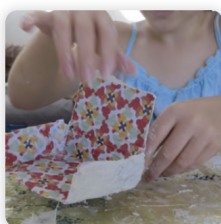

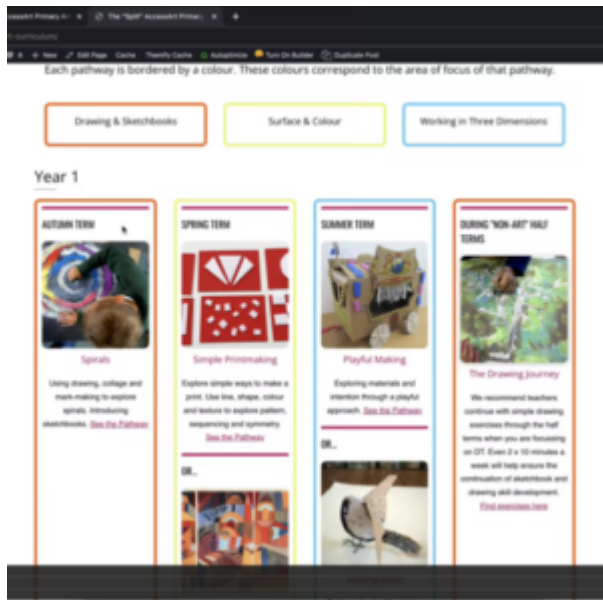

Our holistic curriculum nurtures creative thinking skills, ensuring children learn *through* art, as well as *about* art. We are excited to be able to share with you our Primary Art Curriculum, consisting of 36 pathways for Years 1- 6 (plus [Additional Pathways](#)), designed to inspire and enable high quality visual arts teaching and learning in Primary Schools.

Each year is broken down into six pathways, one for each half-term. Throughout the year students will explore the following disciplines:

Drawing & Sketchbooks

Print, Colour, Collage

Working in Three Dimensions

Paint, Surface, Texture

Working in Two Dimensions

We offer a version of the curriculum for schools teaching art as a full curriculum, split curriculum, for smaller schools teaching mixed age groups and for those who have a split curriculum and teach mixed age groups. 

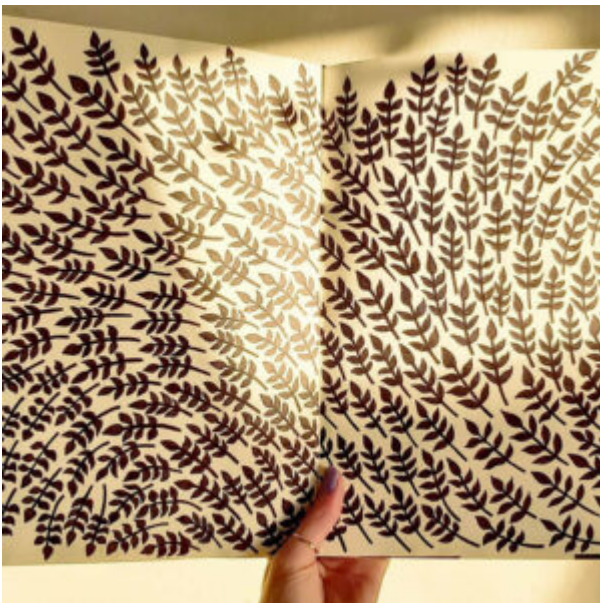
