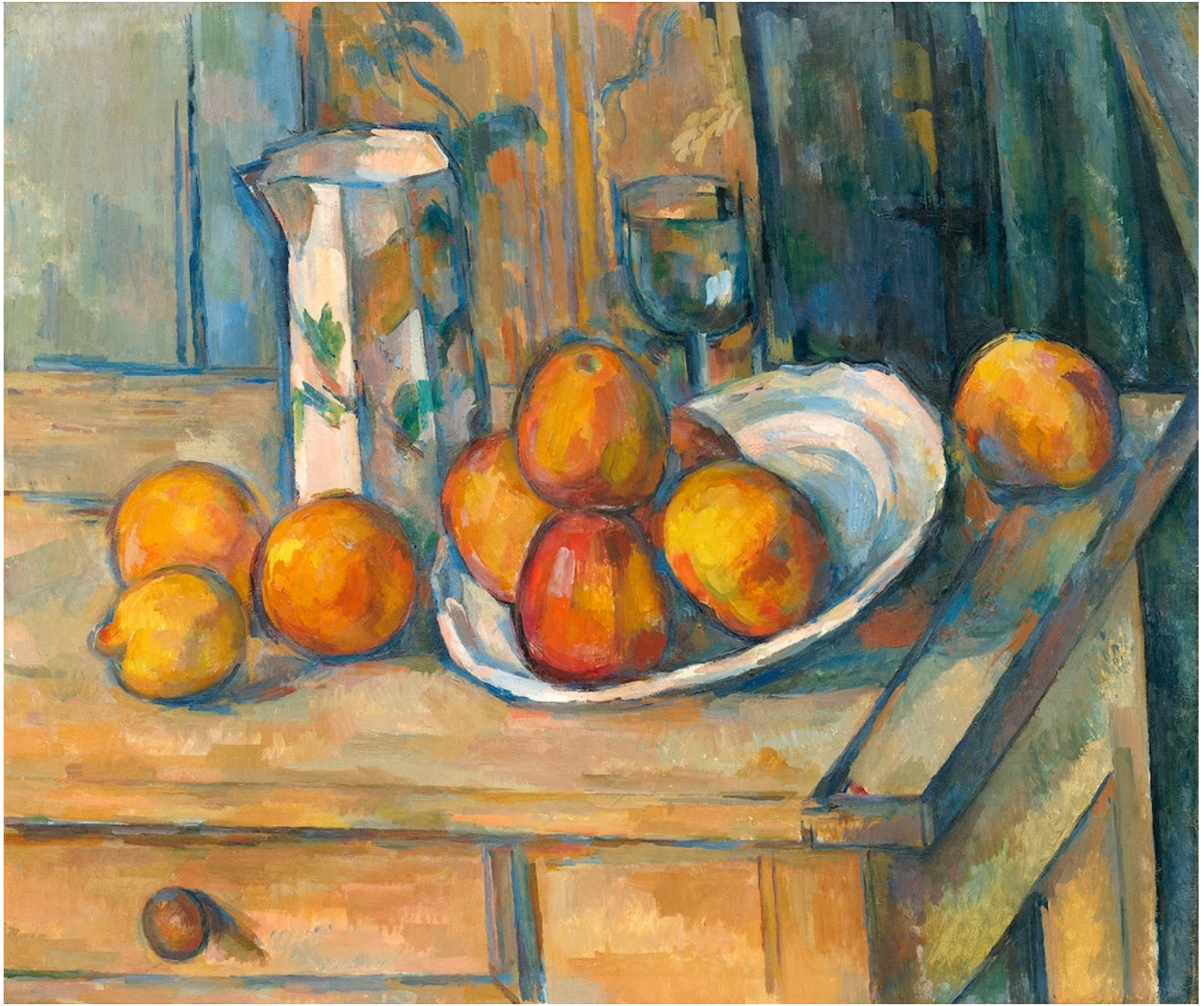


# Session Recording: Still Life Pathway
