

# Session Recording: Still Life Pathway

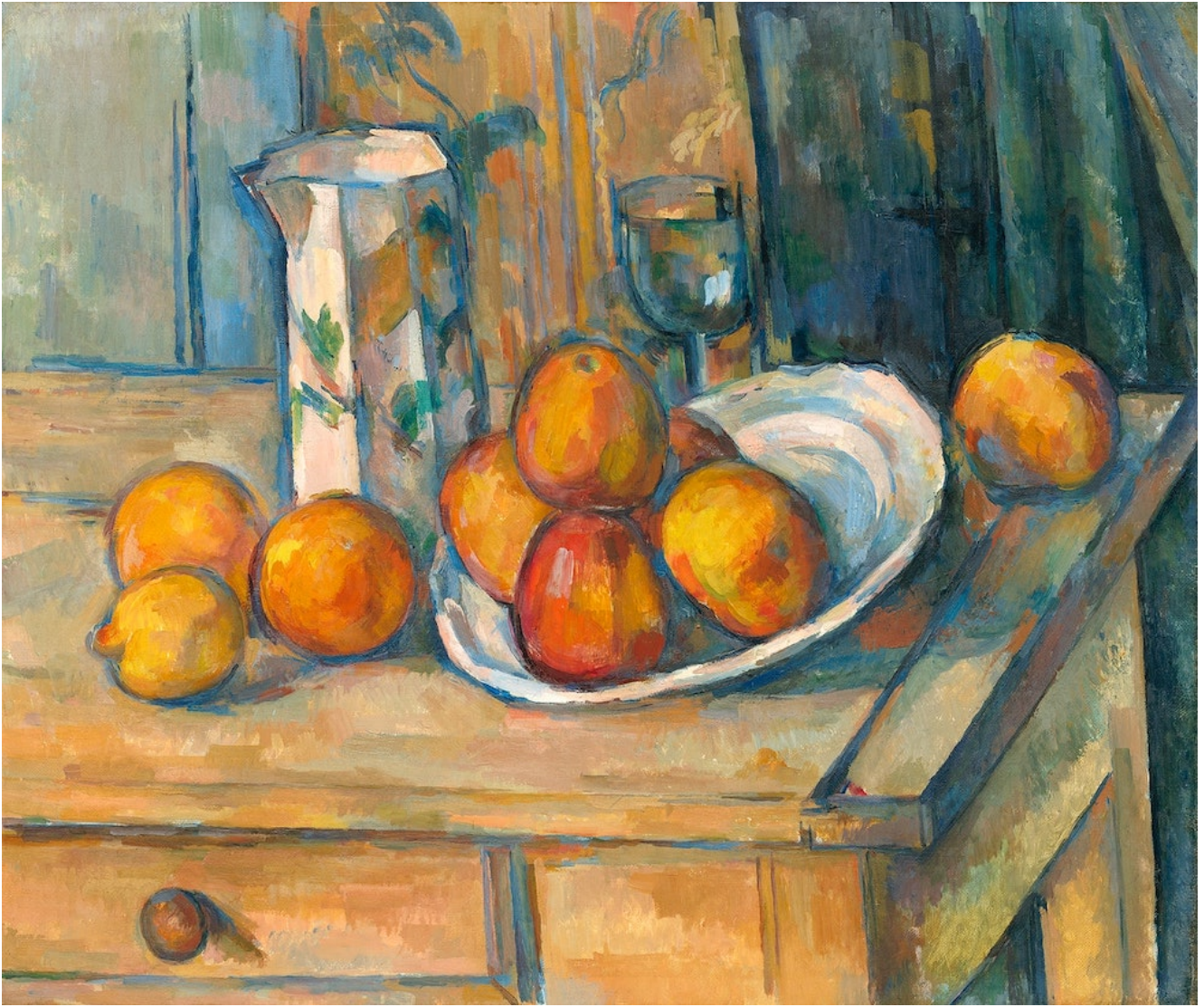
Find a recording of a Zoom session supporting the [Still Life Pathway](#) in our new [Primary Art Curriculum](#).
