This activity is suitable for all teenagers aged 12+, for use in the classroom or workshop environment.



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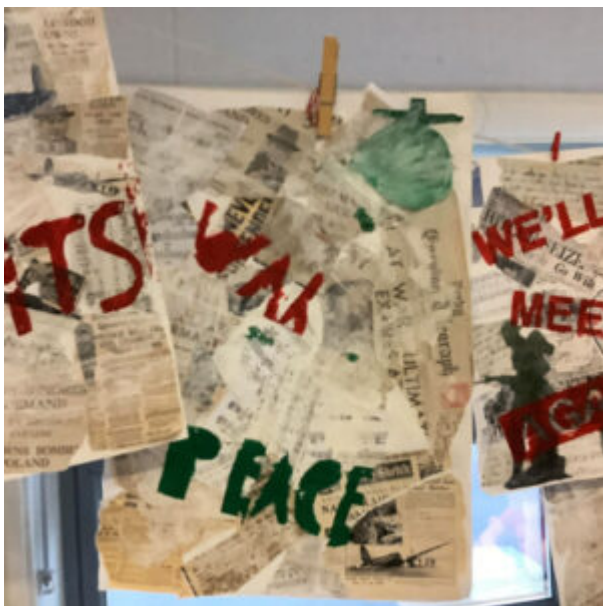
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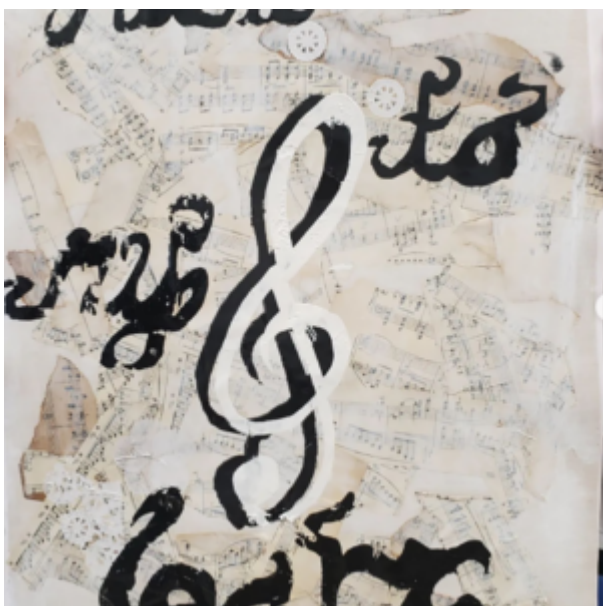
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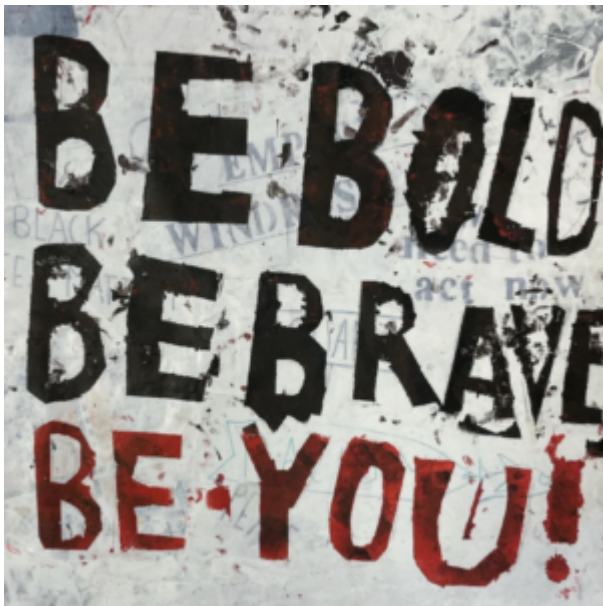
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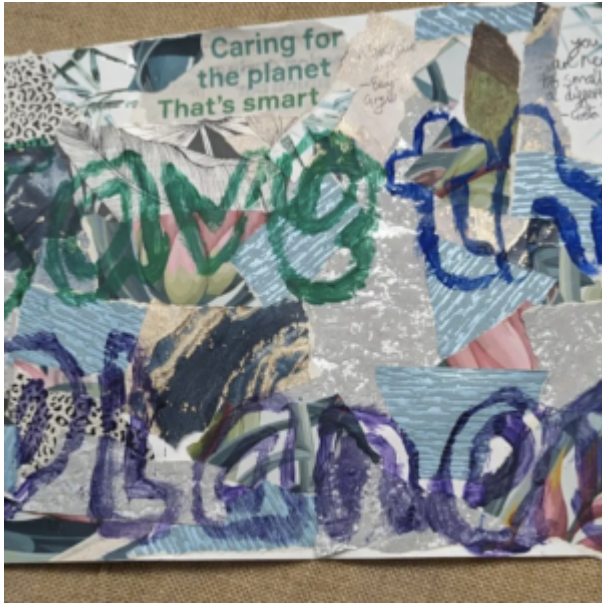












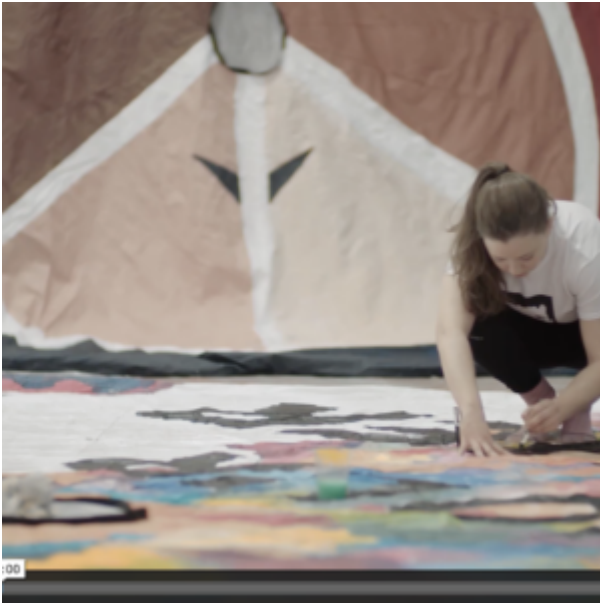
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
