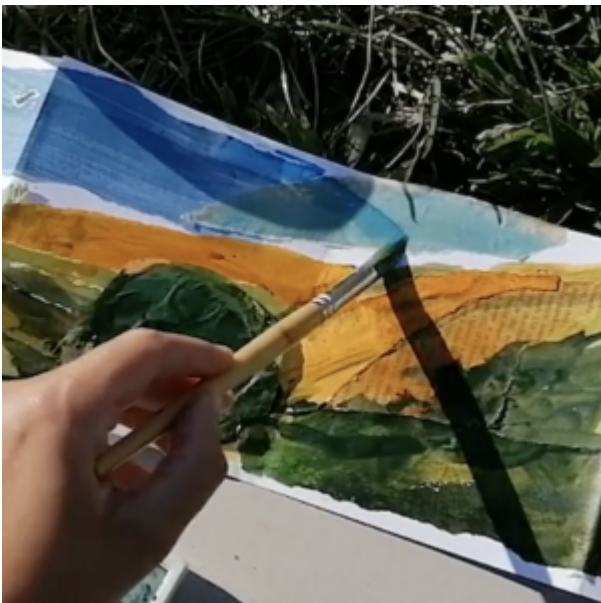
# Explore Collage Below
