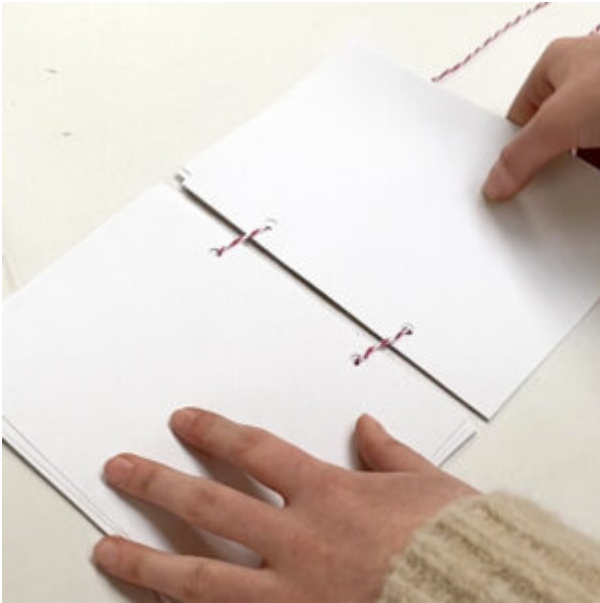

## Make Your Own Sketchbooks

Make a hole punch sketchbook



A hole punch sketchbook is quick and easy to make. They are an excellent and cost effective way to use up old papers

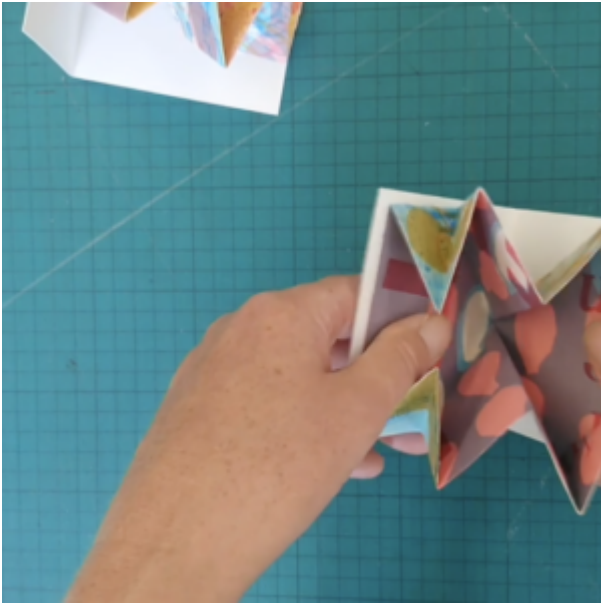

## Fill Your Sketchbooks

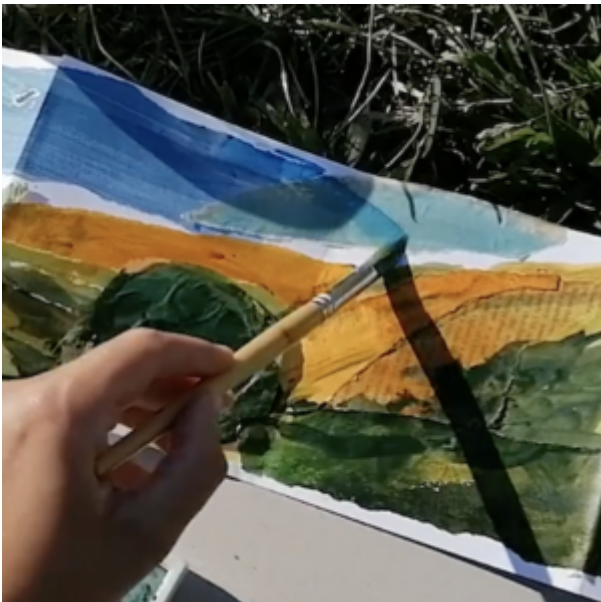
Turkish map fold
