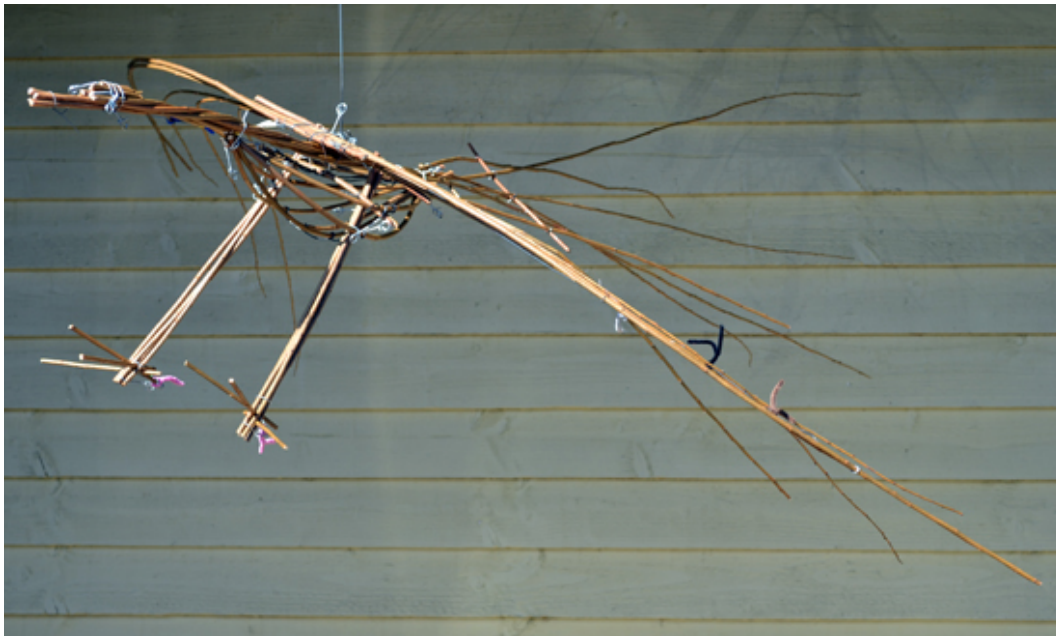


Withy Sculptures
