The AccessArt Primary Art Curriculum is

designed around the idea that art is far more than a series of technical skills. Our holistic curriculum nurtures creative thinking skills, ensuring children learn *through* art, as well as *about* art. You can find out more about the values the curriculum has been built on <u>here</u>.

We are excited to be able to share with you our Primary Art Curriculum, consisting of 36 pathways for Years 1- 6 (plus <u>Additional Pathways</u>), designed to inspire and enable high quality visual arts teaching and learning in Primary Schools.

Each year is broken down into six pathways, one for each half-term. Throughout the year students will explore the following disciplines:

We offer a version of the curriculum for schools teaching art as a full curriculum, split curriculum, for smaller schools teaching mixed age groups and for those who have a split curriculum and teach mixed age groups. We also provide EYFS resources. The curriculum can also be adapted to fit crosscurricular links.
